Subject: Final Mobilization of Qualified Faculty Members and Trade Experts for Registration as National Assessors under the NAVTTTC-Takamol Skills Verification Program (SVP), Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

The National Vocational & Technical Training Commission (NAVTTTC), Government of Pakistan, in collaboration with the **Takamol Skills Verification Program (SVP), Kingdom of Saudi Arabia**, has invited applications from qualified and experienced professionals across Pakistan for registration as **National Assessors** under the Skills Verification Program (SVP) for competency-based assessment of Pakistani skilled workers seeking employment in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

2. This initiative forms part of NAVTTTC's NVQF-aligned **National Assessor Licensing Regime**, aimed at strengthening competency-based assessment and certification systems while supporting international workforce mobility and enhancing the credibility of Pakistan's skilled workforce.

3. Registered National Assessors shall conduct competency-based assessments and practical evaluations in approved trades at SVP-accredited assessment centres across Pakistan and may be engaged by NAVTTTC, Takamol-SVP and NAVTTTC-authorized Qualification Awarding Bodies (QABs), subject to applicable rules and operational requirements.

4. The **Expression of Interest (EOI)** for registration of National Assessors was widely publicized through leading national newspapers on **24 May 2026** and disseminated through NAVTTTC's official communication channels. In order to maximize outreach and provide an opportunity to all eligible professionals across the country, the application deadline has been extended up to **10 July 2026**.
